RULES	This event will be held under Canada Artistic Rules.
BYES	Byes are not required for this event.
SCRATCHES	Scratches may be submitted digitally using the <u>scratch declaration form</u> until the start of the event. Once the competition has begun, scratches must be made on deck at the scoring table.
POOL SIZE	10 Lane 25M pool shallow depth of 2M. FINA certified
GELLING	This will be a gelled meet. Designated areas at the pool will be assigned to accommodate gelling.
AWARDS PROCEDURE	Awards for each event will be held on deck following the conclusion of each event block. Should multiple events be scheduled back to back without a warmup in between, awards for all events in the schedule block will be presented following the conclusion of the last event.

COMPETITION FEES

Each athlete will be charged a officials surcharge fee of \$75.00 each, a bus fee of \$50.00 per coach and \$100.00 per athlete and a meal charge of \$125.00 per athlete and coach.

PAYMENT

ENTRIES CAPACITY

Provinces/federations/clubs are limited to 2 entries in each of 12U Duet, 12U Team, Youth Solo, Youth Male Solo, Youth Duet, Youth Mixed Duet, Youth Team, and Youth Combo. Each of those events has a maximum capacity of 20 entries. If after registration closes, the maximum capacity has not been reached in those events, provinces/ federations/clubs may be invited to add additional entries.

The maximum capacity for Adapted and Mixed Ability events (Adapted Solo, Adapted Duet, Adapted Team, Mixed Ability Duet, Mixed Ability Team) is 20 entries. If that capacity is exceeded, provinces/federations/clubs may be asked to limit their entries.

LATE ENTRIES

Club entry packages which are not received or incomplete upon the stated deadline is automatically subject to a late fine of \$50.00 per routine. In compliance with CAS rule 20.2.2. This fine must be paid to the AAS office. Routines whose fines are not paid will be disqualified from the event.

Late entries or corrections to incomplete entries will be accepted beyond two weeks prior to the event start date, but will be subject to the following fines:

2 weeks prior to first event of the competition:
\$50.00 per correction (to a maximum of \$500.00 per Club)

Within 24 hours of the first event of the competition:
\$100.00 per correction (to a maximum of \$500.00 per Club)

COACH CARD SUBMISSION

SUBMISSION FOLDERS

Coach cards must be submitted into each club's designated Dropbox folder, which will be shared following registration.

RESUBMISSION GUIDELINES

All these coach cards will be imported into the scoring system and considered final, except in the 3 cases below:

Medical Issue

Clubs / provinces / federations who need to change a coach card because of a medical issue that prevents them from performing a routine as per submitted coach card will be allowed to change their coach card up to 2 hours before the start of a session (event blocks will be considered one session). These changes will need to be approved by the event Chief Referee.

Changes between Prelims and Final

In the event of prelims and finals at SYNC, clubs / provinces / federations will be allowed to change their coach cards between prelims and finals but will need to respect deadlines detailed to coaches following registration.

RESUBMISSION GUIDELINES (CONT.)

Last resort desperation move

Clubs / provinces / federations who want to change coach cards for reasons other than the 2 above will be allowed to do so no later than 20:00 the night before an event, but will need to pay a \$100 fine to do so.

New coach cards will always need to be submitted by email to aasevents1789@outlook.com in any of these instances. Confirmation of submission will be provided by email reply.

LABELLING CONVENTIONS

Coach card files must be labelled with the following information, separated by underscores.

- 1. Category**
- 2. Event Name**
- 3. PSO / Club Call Letters**
- 4. Athlete Last Name**

For duets, use both last names. For teams, please use the first swimmer's last name, by alphabetical order.

MUSIC SUBMISSION

MUSIC SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Routine music must be received one week prior to the start of the competition, by dropbox submission which will be shared following registration deadline.

FILE FORMAT

Digital music will be used at this competition. There must be one digital file for each registered routine in an mp3 format, with a minimum required resolution of 192kbps.

Coaches are asked to review each digital file for quality, timing and completeness. Please ensure that volume is consistent throughout all cuts of music.

DROPBOX ACCESS

Following registration, Dropbox folders will be shared with each participating delegation to submit music files into.

LABELLING CONVENTIONS

What is the labelling conventions you would like used for music files?

In Ontario, we follow the CAS conventions:

- 1. Category**
- 2. Event Name**
- 3. Club Call Letters**
- 4. Athlete Last Name**

Provide a few examples to assist.

LABELLING CONVENTIONS

Music files must be labelled with the following information, separated by underscores with NO blank spaces (underscores are acceptable).

- 1. Category**
- 2. Event Name**
- 3. Club/Province/Federation Call Letters**
- 4. Athlete Last Name**

For duets, use both last names. For teams, please use the first swimmer's last name, by alphabetical order

For Example:

Adapted_Solo_WRASC_Smith.mp3
11-12_Duet_ON_Jones-Chen.mp3
Youth_Team_QC_Bryant.mp3

We ask that file names be checked at the metadata level using the following instructions:

Metadata (also known as ID3 tags for MP3 files) is information (such as title, artist, album, genre etc.) that is stored inside the song file.

This is often different from the name of the file itself. In order to avoid confusion at the competition music table, we ask coaches to ensure that the title of the song file, and the ID3 tag title of the song file are the same.

SYNC 2025 12U Development Camp
