CAS COACH REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATION POLICY REQUIREMENTS

GENERAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

RAMP

Registered on RAMP - status must be Active, approved by AAS

CAS SCREENING DISCLOSURE FORM

Completed through RAMP during the registration process

BACKGROUND CHECK

E-Pic through Triton - completed through RAMP Registration

- AS OF January 1, 2026 - all coaches must have a valid Triton E-pic on their profile. Other checks will only be valid if they were completed between September 1 of 2021, and December 31, 2025.**

INCLUSION

SAFE SPORT

Complete Safe Sport Training every 3 years - [The Locker](#)

NCCP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE COMPETITION ENVIRONMENT

Minimally 'Certified Artistic Swimming Competition - Introduction'

Defined as having completed in the following order:

- Complete Comp Intro modules 1-9
- All multi-sport modules prior to evaluations
- Competition Introduction Evaluation - 3 evaluations

To complete your registrations - Register on the [AAS website](#)

Coaches who are *Competition Introduction Trained* (i.e. have completed the Competition Introduction modules 1-9 and all required multi-sport modules as listed above) and are registered and in good standing, have two calendar years from the completion of their *Competition Introduction module 1-8* course to complete their certification, after which they will not be permitted on the deck at any PTSO hosted competition - Section VIII B2 of the CAS Coach Registration and Certification Policy.

This means you must complete all multi-sport modules to be eligible to be on deck at competitions during your first two seasons.
