Participants must complete modules 1-3 through The Locker through the [Coaching Association of Canada](#) (CAC). Platform: Zoom – it is the participant's responsibility to ensure you are prepared. If you do not have the app make sure you have enough time on the start date of the course to follow the link to install the app.

Online registration through RAMP (access is through your own club RAMP account)

Fee: \$65 – paid online at time of registration

Prerequisites: **There are no exceptions to the prerequisites**

- Candidates must be 15 on or before the last day of module 4 – no exceptions
- Must have completed modules 1-3

Course Information:

- A minimum number of 5 must be registered to run the course and a maximum of 20 will be accepted.
- **Candidates must participate via video and audio for all scheduled times.**
- Candidates will be considered registered once AAS has received payment.
- **Candidates will receive a link to participate in the workshop on September 4th.**
- Coaches will be eligible to coach AquaGO! and recreational programs when their status is 'trained' on their NCCP transcript and they meet all other registration requirements as per the CAS Coach Registration and Certification Policy. - The AquaGo! course is the prerequisite to the Competition Introduction Course. Coaches must have 'trained' status to be eligible for the Competition Introduction Course.
