- A minimum number of 5 must be registered to run the course and a maximum of 20 will be accepted.
- Candidates must participate via video and audio.
- Candidates will be considered registered once all prerequisites are completed and AAS has received payment.
- **Candidates will receive a link to participate in the workshop on June 3, 2026.**
- Coaches will be eligible to coach competitive athletes in a training environment for their first year when they have completed modules 1-8 and the following multi-sport modules: Making Headway in Sport, Make Ethical Decisions and Emergency Action Plan.
